1. Record and Approve Apologies.

2. Siting of Memorial Bench.

Cllr Waterhouse updated the group of the working parties meeting the previous Saturday, which favoured siting the WW1 Centenary bench under the cherry tree in front of St Marwenne's Church wall.

It was agreed to remove the old bench which sits in front of the church wall, closest to the Church gate, under the cherry tree, and replace it with the WW1 Centenary bench. Proposed Cllr Perry, Seconded Cllr O'Sullivan. Unanimous.
